# English

For Literacy this term, our Reading and Spelling programs continue; Spelling Mastery 4 times a week and reading groups with various activities such as read to self, reading with the teacher, listening to reading, reading comprehension and more.

In Writing, our focus will be on Information Reports. Through this genre, we will learn about facts vs opinions, structure and purpose of information reports, using paragraphs and will refine our research and note taking skills.

## Science

In Science this term, students will be focusing on Biological Sciences. Students will learn about the seven characteristics of living things.

#### **HASS**

This term for HASS, our focus is Geography. We will be learning about the main climate types of the world and all about Australia's neighbouring countries. We will learn to research and present information in various ways.

# PE with Mr Burge

Fundamental movement skills to be developed through Physical Education will be taught through sport specific skill and game play development in tag rugby league and hockey this term. Fitness will be measured by three standardised tests.

#### Music with Mr Birch

In the Middle Primary Years, students will participate collaboratively with others to produce art and identify the form of songs. We will continue to use elements of music and musical language to provide each other with feedback on performances.

#### **STEM with Elese**

This term, students will be furthering their knowledge of digital systems and learning more about how they work and can be operated. This includes the use of coding robots. Students will also be looking at systems to support winter produce and food technology.

## Indonesian with Bu Chish

'Wayang Kulit' - Students will hear the story of Ramayana through storytelling and drama. They will make wayang kulit (shadow puppets) and learn the cultural background to their use in storytelling. Students will respond to the story in Indonesian and in English.

## Writing with Miss Emma

The focus this term is on information reports. Students will identify the 4 different sentence types. Students will identify key words in texts and develop an understanding of simple, compound and complex sentences.
