Year 3 - Term 4 - Curriculum Overview, 2023



Maths

The proficiency strands of understanding, fluency, problemsolving and reasoning will be embedded into our Maths program. We will also be utilising the Department of Education units of work.

We will use a daily review to recap our previously taught concepts. Topics this term will include shape, angles, location, time and chance.

Science

In Science this term, students will be focusing on Earth and Space Sciences. Students will explore how the Earth's rotation on its axis causes regular changes including night and day.

English

This term, we will be covering two genres – Procedure writing and Poetry.

Within procedure writing we will learn about different types of procedures we see in the real world, features of procedures, language used and identifying verbs, adverbs and adverbial phrases.

Finally, we will begin out unit on Poetry where we get to be creative writers. We will experiment with writing different types of poems and will learn about sound pattern and rhythm as well as a variety of poetic devices.

Writing with Miss Emma

Students will engage in tasks to support them in expanding their sentences. Students will use a range of subordinating conjunctions to create complex sentences to enhance their writing.

HASS

HASS this term is based on History. We are learning about Celebrations around the world such as Chinese New Year, Saint Patrick's Day and more. Students will also learn about the difference between celebrations or commemorations.



PE with Mr Burge

Fundamental movement skills to be developed through Physical Education will be taught through sport specific skill and game play development in baseball 5 and Olympic handball this term. Fitness will be measured by three standardised tests. This semester, Room 22 will have two P.E lessons a week.

Music with Mr Birch

In the middle primary years, students will examine a range of nursery rhymes, before looking at how they can be adapted using musical elements. Ostinati and a variety of songs based on nursery rhymes will be taught with room for students to add and create their own compositions for practice and performance purposes. Only Room 23 will participate in Music this semester.

STEM with Elese

This term students will be exploring how to solve problems by collaborating with others. They will be using a range of strategies to record the design process and present their process to others. They will look into the benefits food technologies provide for health and food safety, and explore how food can be prepared for healthy eating.

Indonesian with Bu Chish

'Rumah saya' (My house) – Students will be learning how to describe their/and other houses using adjectives. They will be looking at rooms in a house and learning how to say what part of their daily routine occurs in each room. Students will be describing who lives in their household.

The Arts - Dance

This term all classes R - 6 will be engaging in dance as preparation for our '*End* of Year Concert'. The '*End* of Year Concert' will take place on Thursday the 7th December and serves two purposes for us here at Largs Bay School. Firstly, for students to hone their choreographic and performance skills and an appreciation of their own and others' dances and secondly, as a community event and celebration.
