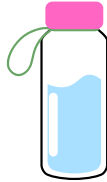

Monday 28th September - Excursion - The Beachouse

Join us for an action-packed day at The Beachouse! Get ready for fun on the water slides, bumper boats, arcade games and the indoor playground. There's something for everyone to enjoy! Children **MUST** bring / wear a rashie that covers their shoulders. The bus will depart at 9:15am and will return by 1:00pm.

Tuesday 29th September - In House - Paint, Plant & Grow

Children are invited to join us for a hands on day of art and gardening! Children will paint and decorate their own ceramic pot before planting seeds to take home and watch grow. We'll also spend time exploring our school gardens, helping to plant new seedlings, remove weeds, and learn how to care for plants and our environment. Please ensure children wear clothes that are ok to get dirty.

Wednesday 30th September - In House - Baking Day

Join us for a fun-filled day of baking! Children will enjoy getting hands-on in the kitchen as we bake a variety of delicious treats, including cookies, rocky road, and cupcakes. We'll also put our creativity to the test with a fun decorating challenge, where everyone can decorate their own sweet treat masterpiece! Please ensure children are wearing enclosed shoes and clothes that are ok to get messy!

Thursday 1st October - Incursion - Street Beats

Back by popular demand! Street Beats will join us at OSHC today with an immersive music experience. Children will be provided with wireless headsets and guided through interactive audio missions full of music, games and dancing. Through storytelling and sound, they'll follow clues, move to the beat, and enjoy a unique group experience designed to get everyone involved. This session isn't just about dancing - it's about teamwork, movement, listening, and having a blast with friends as we explore rhythm and sound.

Friday 2nd October - In House - Bingo

Eyes down, it's Bingo time! Children will enjoy a fun-filled day playing with real bingo books, just like the grown-ups! We'll mix things up with a variety of exciting bingo games throughout the day, with plenty of prizes to be won along the way!

Monday 5th October - Labour Day Public Holiday - OSHC is **CLOSED!**

Tuesday 6th October - Incursion - SciWorld

Today children will enjoy two exciting interactive experiences brought to them by SciWorld! They will begin their adventure in the StarLab Milky Way Planetarium, where they'll step inside a giant inflatable dome and be taken on an immersive journey through space. They'll explore the Australian night sky, discover the wonders of the Milky Way, learn about planets, stars, galaxies, and our solar system, all brought to life with incredible 360-degree digital projections.

The excitement continues with the spectacular Fire & Ice Show, where children will witness amazing science demonstrations using the extremes of heat and cold, discovering how different temperatures cause materials to change!

Wednesday 7th October - Incursion - Street Beats Fluro Glowing Adventure Room

Street Beats is back with an exciting new glow-in-the-dark experience! Our hall will be transformed into a glowing adventure room using UV lighting! ***Children are encouraged to wear white or neon clothing*** to enhance the visual effects and will receive glow sticks and glow-in-the-dark body crayons to join in the fun.

During the session, children will take part in a variety of interactive games, challenges, and team quests while surrounded by glowing lights and music.

****Please note: There will be bright lights and higher noise levels throughout the day due to the planned activities. Limited headphones are available from OSHC however no alternative spaces will be available for use. If your child has noise sensitivities, they are welcome to bring their own headphones from home.**

Thursday 8th October - Walking Excursion - Roy Martin Playground

Prepare for an exciting day of outdoor adventure at Roy Martin Park! Explore the playground, sandpit and water play, enjoy ball games on the courts or grass! Fees:

Vacation care cost is \$62.50 per child per day or \$67.50 for a casual booking - (made after the booking due date - 9am Monday 14th September).

CCS entitlements are claimable for families who are registered with Centrelink.

Bookings:

Booking and excursion permission forms must be submitted to OSHC no later than 9am Monday 14th September 2026.

Bookings received after this date will incur the casual booking fee.

Acceptance of bookings is based on availability.

OSHC accounts must be up to date to ensure your booking can be accepted.

If you require care for your child/ren over the school holidays, please complete and return a booking/excursion permission form to the OSHC office or via email to oshc.largsbay966@schools.sa.edu.au.

Bookings are taken on a first in, first serve basis. Largs Bay Primary students receive booking priority.

Bookings for children who do not attend Largs Bay Primary School open 9am Monday 14th September.

Cancellation Policy:

Vacation Care has a '**No Cancellation Policy**'. Consideration will be given at the Director's discretion for a cancellation due to sickness, if a medical certificate is provided and or if your child's vacancy can be filled.

Clothing:

Children are required to wear appropriate clothing. This includes comfortable shoes/sandals, tops with sleeves - no singlets and clothing appropriate to the weather. All children are to wear their **RED OSHC HAT**. If your child/ren do not have one or it has been lost, a new hat will be issued to your account for a charge of \$15. OSHC will provide sunscreen regularly as per the sun smart policy.

Behaviour Policy:

At Largs Bay OSHC we encourage positive behaviour and have a duty of care to all our students to ensure their safety and wellbeing whilst in our care. Students who demonstrate negative or inappropriate behaviour will be re-directed. If such behaviour continues or the behaviour is deemed serious by leadership, the decision may be made to suspend the child from our OSHC program. This is in line with the Department for Education Guidelines and the service's Behaviour Management Policy.

Medical Management Plan & Medication

All children diagnosed with medical conditions, including allergies, food intolerances, anaphylaxis, asthma, and epilepsy, must provide the following:

- A completed Medical Management Plan
- Medical Condition Risk Minimisation Plan & Communication Plan
- Necessary medication with the pharmacy label.

Please note that providing these documents is a legal requirement under the Education & Care National Regulations. For the safety of the children, care may be refused on the day if the appropriate documentation or medication is not supplied.

Staff to Child Ratios and Risk Assessments

Our service is licensed for 100 child places. We staff with the ratio of 1 staff member to 15 children for in house activities and 1:10 for excursions. These ratios at times may vary, (higher staff per child ratio), dependent on the risk assessment carried out. Risk assessments are completed for all excursions and activities carried out at the service and may be viewed upon request.
